Since the last communiqué which you received on April 15th, the SAS-CSD negotiation committee met the CPNSSS (employers' Committee of negotiation for health and social services) at the end of last week.

The purpose of the meeting was to revise the exploratory global deposit as submitted by the employers' representatives on April 5th.

Several modifications or withdrawals were brought. The discussions concern, among others, the following subjects:

- Flexible time management;
- Availability of the workforce;
- Medical arbitration (modalities);
- Cost of the meals and indexation.

Without disagreeing totally with certain proposed demands, it is necessary to understand that your negotiation committee came back with few already refused demands, which we think deserve to be re-discussed.

We do not wish for a one-way negotiation. It is clear that we must obtain good concessions from the employer concerning the working conditions of the members.

The ball is in the camp of the CPNSSS and we hope for a positive progress in the next days to obtain a negotiated agreement.
